STATEMENT

On 2 March 1945, Missien Y-21-7, I was flying Yellew two and 2d Lt. Refert H. Strong was flying Red four. We were under an evercust (10/10) and the visibility was approximately 4 to 6 miles. We had spetted the target and Red flight was to strafe while Yellow flight covered them. As ked flight made their run I was in position to watch them all. When Red four was strafing light flak opened up with a fairly short burnt from the woods to his left. As he pulled off the target I could see his right wing smoking and from the angle the flak came from Lt. Strong must have also been hit in the cockpit. As he pulled up I heard, who I thought was Yellow leader, call telling It. Strong to bail out. He pulled up to about 1,000 feet, half-relied and went into the ground. The plane exploded and burned when it hit. Lt. Strong did not tail out.
